

## CODE OF CONDUCT AND GENERAL RULES TO FOLLOW 2017

1. The Miss Clatsop County Scholarship Program is a volunteer organization run strictly by volunteers. Treat everyone appropriately, and positively acknowledge sponsors and businesses donating services or products.
2. Dress rehearsal Friday is a closed rehearsal – friends and families are asked to sit in the very back few rows. NO photography.
3. At the Friday night benefit dinner, contestants will be expected to introduce themselves to guests both publicly and privately.
4. No one is permitted backstage or in the dressing rooms at any time during rehearsal or production except security, stage personnel, pageant officials and other delegated individuals.
5. The Miss Clatsop County Scholarship Program will provide professionals to **assist** with hair and make-up backstage. However, contestants are encouraged to do their own hair and meet with the professionals prior to rehearsal regarding their hair and makeup desires and concerns. No personal hairdressers or make-up artists will be allowed. If the contestant continues to Miss Oregon, contestant is responsible for their own hair and make-up.
6. Label everything that you bring with you: shoes, clothing, make-up, hair supplies, etc. The Miss Clatsop County Scholarship Program is not responsible for items left at Encore Dance Studio, Seaside Convention Center or any other location. All efforts will be made to locate and return lost items to the owner.
7. The Miss Clatsop County Scholarship Program will be paying for contestants at the Friday Benefit Dinner & dinner (lunch / dinner) on Saturday afternoon – all other meals are the responsibility of the contestants.
8. Water will be provided to contestants. No outside water bottles or other liquids are allowed unless prior approval is made with program officials.
9. Bring all medications needed with you and advise program officials (Sandy Newman/Celle Sollars-Malehorn) as to what you are taking.
10. Imbibing in any alcoholic or substance abuse will result in immediate suspension of further participation and removal from the pageant system.
11. Facebook and other social media outlets are available for all to see and will be monitored for inappropriate actions.
12. Smoking is not permitted at any time.
13. All awards are given in the form of scholarship certificates. Scholarships come directly from the Miss Oregon Scholarship Foundation.
14. If crowned Miss Clatsop County, Miss North Coast, Miss Clatsop County's Outstanding Teen, or Miss North Coast's Outstanding Teen or any other title additional appearance dates will be outlined.
15. Any contestant whose conduct is deemed unbecoming by the Miss Clatsop County Scholarship Program Board and is in violation of her contract with the organization during the process of, preparing for, during the production of, or after coronation can be disqualified and / or stripped of her title.
